

Laois County Council will not accept planning applications/applications for percolation tests unless the maps accompanying the application are original Ordnance Survey Ireland maps carrying a red stamp or stamped with a licence number from the Ordnance Survey Office.

Planning applications should be accompanied by:

- Six number copies of 6" Ordnance Survey maps, scale 1 : 10560, indicating location of site,
- All maps must be original Ordnance Survey maps carrying a red stamp or stamped with a licence number from the Ordnance Survey Office.
- Six number copies of 25" Ordnance Survey maps scale 1: 2500, with site boundaries outlined in red. Adjacent land in the applicants control must be outlined in blue and way leaves in yellow. In all cases, the number of the Ordnance Survey map should be clearly indicated thereon.
- All maps must be original Ordnance Survey maps carrying a red stamp or stamped with a licence number from the Ordnance Survey Office.

An application for a percolation test should be accompanied by:

- Two number copies of 6" Ordnance Survey maps scale 1: 10560, indicating location of site.
- All maps must be original Ordnance Survey maps carrying a red stamp or stamped with a licence number from the Ordnance Survey Office.

- Two number copies of Ordnance Survey maps scale 1:2500 indicating location of maps.
