53. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON THE 28th OF MARCH 2011

On the proposition of Councillor William Aird seconded by Councillor John Joe Fennelly, the Minutes of the March Meeting of Laois County Council held on the 28th of March 2011 were confirmed as circulated.

54. VOTE OF SYMPAHTY

On the proposition of Councillor John Joe Fennelly seconded by Councillor Michael Lalor and unanimously agreed, a vote of sympathy was extended to the Burroughs family on the tragic death of Diane.

55. WELCOME TO STUDENTS

The Cathaoirleach welcomed the New Directions group to the Council Meeting.

56. ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENET 2010 INCLUDING APPROVAL OF OVER-EXPENDITURE AND TRANSFERS TO CAPITAL

Mr. Gerry Murphy, Head of Finance briefed the Members on the Annual Financial Statement for 2010. Mr. Murphy advised that the Council's capital position had improved significantly from a debit balance of €4,951,565 at the end of 2009 to a reduced debit balance of €1,788,317 at the end of 2010. On the revenue side, a surplus of €2,104 was achieved by 31st of December 2010. He advised that this is a very positive outcome for the Council particularly having regard to the various budgetary difficulties during 2010. The Head of Finance also informed Members of any over-expenditure which had occurred to which approval was required and outlined details of same.

The Head of Finance extended thanks to Ms. Julie Bergin, Financial Accountant & all the staff in the Finance Department for the significant work carried out in the preparation of the A.F.S.

On the proposition of Councillor John Moran seconded by Councillor John Joe Fennelly, the Members unanimously adopted the Annual Financial Statement 2010 including approval of over-expenditure and transfers to capital.

The Members welcomed the report and complimented the Mr. Gerry Murphy, Head of Finance and all staff in the Finance Section under the leadership of Mr. GerryMurphy, Head of Finance.

57. REPORT ON DEVELOPMENT CONTRIBUTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 48 OF THE PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2000

Mr. Gerry Murphy, Head of Finance briefed the Members on the Development Contributions in accordance with Section 48 of the Planning & Development Act, 2000. He explained the contents of the report and how funds were expended during the year. The report also outlines proposals for expenditure in 2011.

58. DRAFT LAOIS COUNTY COUNCIL ANNUAL REPORT 2010

Ms. Anna Marie Delaney, Director of Services indicated to the Members that the Local Government Act, 2011 requires that a draft report be presented to the Members by the 30th of April. The Members were circulated with a copy of the draft report. On the proposition of Councillor William Aird seconded by Councillor James Daly, the Members unanimously agreed to adopt the draft Laois County Council Annual Report for 2010.

Councillor Jerry Lodge requested that on Page 29 that L.A.B.E.L. be amended to the Laois Third Level Initiative.

59. UPDATE ON ARTHOUSE DEVELOPMENT AT STRADBALLY, COUNTY LAOIS

Mr. Declan Byrne, Director of Services gave a presentation on the Arthouse Development at Stradbally, County Laois and it's facilities. The official opening is on the 13th of May 2011. The Cathaoirleach acknowledged the work of Mr. Declan Byrne, Director of Services and all involved in the completion of this project.

The County Manager, Mr. Peter Carey welcomed the completion of the project and also complimented the Members on their positive leadership and also to Mr. Declan Byrne, Director of Services and his staff.
