160. DISPOSAL OF LAND UNDER SECTION 183 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 2001

(I) LEASE OF 1.52 ACRES OF LAND AT STRADBALLY, CO. LAOIS IN THE TOWNLAND OF STRADBALLY FOR A PERIOD OF 6 YEARS FOR A CONSIDERATION OF €500 PER ANNUM

On the proposition of Councillor Ray Cribbin seconded by Councillor Paul Mitchell, the Members unanimously agreed to the lease of 1.52 acres of land at Stradbally, Co. Laois in the townland of Stradbally for a period of 6 years for a consideration of \notin 500 per annum.

(ii) DISPOSAL OF 0.18 ACRES OF LAND AT FAIRMOUNT IN THE TOWNLAND OF DOONANE, 16 CHATSWORTH HOUSE, CHATSWORTH STREET, CASTLECOMER, CO. KILKENNY FOR A CONSIDERATION OF €5,000

On the proposition of Councillor James Daly seconded by Councillor John King, the Members unanimously agreed to the disposal of 0.18 acres of land at Fairmount in the townland of Doonane, 16 Chatsworth House, Chatsworth Street, Castlecomer, Co. Kilkenny for a consideration of €5,000.

161. APPROVAL OF BYE-LAWS MADE UNDER THE CONTROL OF HORSES ACT, 1996 (AGREED BY HOUSING & SOCIAL STRATEGIC POLICY COMMITTEE ON THE 22ND OF NOVEMBER 2011)

The Members were circulated with a copy of the bye-laws made under the Control of Horses Act, 1996 which had been agreed at the Strategic Policy Committee held on the 22nd of November 2011. The new bye-laws will come into effect from the 1st of January 2012 and the main purpose is to give effect to the reduced period of detention for stray animals from 10 to 5 days.

On the proposal of Councillor James Deegan and seconded by Councillor Alan Hand, the Members unanimously approved the bye-laws made under the Control of Horses Act, 1996.

162. MUSIC GENERATION – LAOIS – PRESENTATION BY MS. NUALA KELLY, CO-ORDINATOR, LAOIS SCHOOL OF MUSIC
