## Schedule 2a Assessment

<b>Criteria for determining whether the Material Amendments to the Draft Plan is likely to have significant effects on the environment</b>
<b>1. The characteristics of the plan having regard, in particular, to:</b>
<b><i>the degree to which the Plan sets a framework for projects and other activities, either with regard to the location, nature, size and operating conditions or by allocating resources,</i></b>
The material amendments, relate to the provisions of the draft LAP that in itself will provide the framework for landuse planning and projects in the plan area. No material amendments are identified as requiring site specific mitigation measures in relation to avoidance of likely significant effects on the European Sites or other SEA parameters
<b><i>the degree to which the Plan influences other plans, including those in a hierarchy,</i></b>
The material amendments relate to the draft LAP which will operate as the landuse framework for the plan area once adopted. It sits within a hierarchy of landuse plans, of which the Laois County Development Plan (CDP) 2017 -2023 is the primary county plan. The LAP has been prepared having regard to the policies and objectives outlined within the CDP 2017-2023 and in turn higher tier plans
<b><i>the relevance of the Plan in the integration of environmental considerations in particular with a view to promoting sustainable development,</i></b>
The existing draft LAP provides for a suite of environmental considerations and these measures contribute to the promotion of sustainable development in light of the LAP objectives
<b><i>Environmental problems relevant to the Plan</i></b>
The assessment in the material amendments report shows that no conflicts with SEOS are identified for material amendments, and therefore no mitigation measures are recommended
<b><i>the relevance of the Plan to the implementation of European Union legislation on the environment (e.g. plans linked to waste-management or water protection).</i></b>
The Draft Plan provides a landuse framework for the plan area and has been subject to SEA to date. The SEA, and other environmental assessments including Appropriate Assessment and Flood Risk Assessment considered and integrated European Union legislation on the environment including those relating to topics such as Waste Management and Water protection

The proposed material amendments would not be likely to result in significant environmental effects

The proposed material amendments would not be likely to result in significant environmental effects in this regard

The proposed material amendments would not be likely to result in significant environmental effects as detailed in the individual assessment of material alterations in the material amendment report

The proposed material amendments would not be likely to result in significant environmental effects as detailed in the individual assessment of material alterations in the material amendment report.
<b><i>the value and vulnerability of the area likely to be affected due to:</i></b>
<b><i>(a) special natural characteristics or cultural heritage:</i></b> No such effects are identified
<b><i>(b) exceeded environmental quality standards or limit values:</i></b> It is anticipated that environmental quality standards will not be exceeded by the draft LAP nor the material alterations
<b><i>(c) intensive land-use:</i></b> No significant environmental effects are identified for material amendments proposed
<b><i>(d) the effects on areas or landscapes which have a recognised national, European Union or international protection status:</i></b> The Screening for appropriate assessment has not identified, likely significant effects arise in relation to conservation management objectives of European Sites.
