**The Planning and Development (Laois County Development Plan 2017 - 2023)
Direction 2017**

On 28th September 2017, Mr. Damien English, Minister of State at the Department of Housing, Planning, and Local Government pursuant to the powers and duties conferred on him by the Housing, Planning, Community and Local Government (Delegation of Ministerial Functions) (No. 2) Order 2017 (SI No. 352 of 2017) issued a Direction under Section 31 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) directing that Laois County Council take the following steps with regard to the Laois County Development Plan 2017 - 2023:

- (i) The text in Policy EN7 is to be deleted as shown below:
Ensure a setback distance of 1.5 km of Wind turbines from schools, dwellings, community centres and all public roads in all areas open for consideration for wind farm development.
- (ii) The text in Section 6.1 of Appendix 5 - Wind Energy Strategy is to be deleted as shown below:
Ensure a setback distance of 1.5 kms of wind turbines from schools, dwellings, community centres and all public roads in all areas open for consideration for wind farm development.
- (iii) The Map 1.6.5 - Wind Energy as adopted is to be removed. A copy of the said map is attached as Appendix 1 to the direction.
And
The Map 1.6.5 - Wind Energy as included in the Draft Laois County Development Plan 2017-2023 is to be included.
A copy of the said map is attached as Appendix 2 to the direction.
